MISSION OPPORTUNITIES FOR JUNE: June 7th--Sorting clothing for Program of Hope will occur in Fellowship Hall following Worship on Sunday. Please bring any donations by that date and prepare to stay a bit longer to size the clothing donated thus far. John Calvin Presbyterian is scheduled to bring lunches to Program of Hope every Wednesday in June. Volunteers are needed to join them at 8:30 on Wednesday mornings.

Jefferson Presbyterian Church Food Bank (4450 Jefferson Hwy). At the Church on the 1st and 3rd Saturdays of each month grocery bags of food are given to qualified, registered folks between 9-11am. Food is packed at the church on the Thursdays prior to their distribution. Filling the grocery bags begins at 7am and usually lasts until 9 am. Dates are as follows: Thursday bag filling: June 4, June 18. Saturday bag distribution: June 6, June 20.

NEW OPPORTUNITY: Let's help fill those bags of groceries for two months by donating one specific item to each bag--a **single pound of rice**. The Food Bank fills 300 bags of groceries per month, giving a total of 600 bags of groceries for two months. This is very ambitious! I pray that God blesses our efforts to help feed 600 families with this one small purchase! You can begin bringing your rice on 6/7 and place them in the bin in the Sanctuary.
